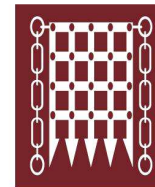

What lessons can be learnt from preparation on being GDPR compliant, including internal processes in place to ensure personal data breaches are reported within 72 hours, and as the Data Protection Bill passes through Parliament, what more can be done to better enable use of data?*
